

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS IN ADVANCED PRACTICUM

TIME FRAME:

- A minimum of **six months** between Basic Intensive and Advanced Intensive Weeks is required.
- A **minimum of eighteen (18) months** between attendance at the **Basic Intensive Training** and attendance at **Certification** is current policy.
- Should the time frame between completion of the Advanced Practicum and participation in a Certification Week exceed 6 months, participants are required to review with a Practicum Supervisor to refresh their knowledge and skills by completing the **Practicum Learning Guide** (Learning Instrument for Practicum Self Evaluation and Co-verification) which can be obtained from Glasser Australia.

HOURS:

- The Practicum must consist of a minimum of **thirty (30)** hours.
- At least **12-15** of these hours are to be face-to-face.
- All of these time requirements are stated as a **minimum**. It is the responsibility of the Advanced Practicum Supervisor to determine, based upon demonstrated knowledge and skills, the actual time requirements for each participant.

PREPARATION FOR CERTIFICATION*:

- Advanced Practicum is a preparation for attendance at Certification Training.
- The participant is required to read further texts by Dr Glasser.
- Emphasis is on supporting further integration of CTRTLM ideas into the participant's own life.
- Participants concentrate on more intensive practices as coach, counsellor and client.
- Emphasis is placed on the development of the participant's own Quality Work, which is a self-directed piece of work created with a focus on some aspect of Dr Glasser's concepts. Participants will be required to present this to their Certification group.
